Since the conclusion of our Conference on April 27, some attendees have tested positive for COVID-19. Although it is unknown where these individuals became infected, we are reaching out to all conference participants out of caution and our Association's commitment to transparency. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) states that COVID-19 symptoms may appear two to 14 days after exposure to the virus—and the agency also reminds that some individuals who become infected may not show symptoms, even though they can still transmit the virus to others.
